

## XCamp 2024 FAQs

### **Can my kids be on a team with their friends or siblings?**

- No, kids will rotate with other kids in their similar grades (Kindergarten and 1st grade, 2nd and 3rd grade, 4th and 5th grade will rotate as teams together) for all three of our rotations. If friends or siblings are in the same grade, they can do everything together. We cannot accommodate special requests at this time.

### **Can I move my child to the afternoon/morning session?**

- No, we ask that your child stays in the session they were originally registered for.

### **Can my child attend if they will be starting Kindergarten in the Fall 2024?**

- No, to make it the safest possible experience for kids attending, underage kids will not be allowed to attend. Only kids currently in (or just completed) Kindergarten by May 2024 through 5th grade (finishing 5th grade in May 2024) will be permitted to attend.

### **Can my 6th grader attend?**

- No, to make it the best possible experience for kids attending, no kids over the age of 5th grade will be allowed to attend. They should be completing 5th grade May 2024. Current 6th graders through existing 12th graders are invited to join us at Rally, an event tailored just for them.

### **Can my 6th grader volunteer?**

- No, we ask that youth volunteers be at least a High School Freshman (15 years and older) to volunteer for this event.

### **Do I get a discount if I volunteer at camp?**

- No, this year, Sagebrush is investing so much into XCamp to make it affordable to everyone that we cannot offer any discounts.

### **Are there scholarships available for camp?**

- No, this year, Sagebrush is investing so much into XCamp to make it affordable to everyone that we cannot offer any scholarships.

### **Can I sponsor a child for XCamp?**

- We have a general giving fund for the camp that will help us offset the cost and offer an affordable camp experience to everyone. Feel free to donate any amount you would like, but we cannot save it for any specific child or family.

### **My child has a medical condition. Should I put their medication in their bag?**

- For the safety of your child and those around them, we ask that all medications be dropped off in the First Aid Room (Snails, Room #100) so that the medical team can monitor them and contact parents if needed.

### **How can I help?**

### **Can I volunteer in a specific area or with the child I am registering for XCamp?**

- No, due to our overwhelming need for help with XCamp, we cannot accommodate special requests unless there is a medical need. We encourage you to sign-up to help guide the kids through the exciting activities that we have planned! XCamp is a fun and rewarding way to volunteer with Kids Planet.

### **Will there be walk-up registrations this year?**

- Due to the overwhelming excitement about XCamp this year, both of our camp sessions have completely filled up, and we will not be offering walk-up registration. If your child has not already been registered for this event, they cannot attend this year.

### **Can I pick up my child early?**

- To ensure your child has the best experience possible, we ask that they stay for the entire session. In the event of an emergency, we will allow early pick-up.

### **Whom do I contact in the case of an emergency?**

- If you have an emergency and need to contact your child during camp, please call our church phone number at 505-922-9200. For your child's safety and those around them, we ask that you do not try to locate your child – we will send a staff member to get them.

### **Will there be transportation from the multisites to Riverside?**

- In most cases, transportation will not be provided. You will be responsible for dropping off and picking up your child at the Riverside campus. However, if you attend the Highland, Los Lunas, or Santa Fe Campuses, you are strongly encouraged to contact your Kid's Captain to see if other arrangements have been made. Kids being bussed to XCamp will be able to attend the PM session.

### **Is food provided?**

- Kids will receive water and allergy-friendly snacks throughout the camp; however, we will not serve any meals. So please make sure that your child has eaten before dropping them off.

### **Will you have sunscreen available for my child?**

- We ask that they arrive with sunscreen already applied. Sunscreen is available at multiple stations for your child to use throughout their session.
